



4th consortium meeting, April 3 – 5, 2023 in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam

The 4th ICT-INOV consortium meeting took place on April 3 – 5, 2023 in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. The meeting was organized by John Von Neumann Institute, which belongs to the Vietnam National University academic network. The meeting was attended by 29 participants, representing project partners.

During the meeting partners had the opportunity to collaborate on all aspects of the project implementation, including the design and development of the digital learning services, the development of educational activities for innovation, piloting in courses, instructor training, development of good practice guidelines, organization of community building events, organization of final project conference, dissemination, project management, and quality assurance.

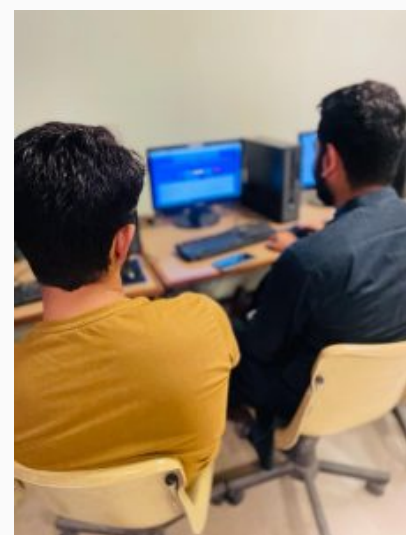


More specifically, partners performed a review of the functionality of the project digital learning platform, which is complete and in use by students and educators. Partners discussed enhancements and bug fixes that were suggested in the context of piloting activities. In addition, partners worked towards the translation of the available user interface to their national languages in order to increase the impact of the platform.

Piloting in courses

The ICT-INOV learning intervention on gamified design thinking towards innovation is deployed in courses in real-life educational contexts at all partner sites.

Until now, the ICT-INOV has been used in **34 courses** where **over 2500 students** have been engaged.



Instructor training events

In addition to the plenary instructor training that engages all partners, local instructor training is planned at each partner site in the 2nd half of the project implementation period.

Until now there have been **28 events** and **over 300 instructors** participate in these events.
